

IMPORTANT UPDATE – MEMBERS’ TIME SHEETS & CONDITIONS OF PLAY EFFECTIVE 1ST DEC, 2020



We continue to monitor the impact of Covid-19 on Golf operations and wish to advise members of the following changes:

Time Sheets:

Time sheets for competitions from Thursday 10th December and Saturday 12th December will revert back to normal timesheets with draws conducted in the clubhouse on Wednesday (for Thursday comp) and Friday (for Saturday comp), 8 days prior, from 6.30pm. The timesheets will then become available on-line and in the clubhouse at 8pm on the night of the draw.

To facilitate the booking process and assist with social distancing, members will be provided with a booking slip for them to record details of players that they are booking in. It is recommended that the membership **name and number** of all players in the group is provided to assist in expediting the booking process.

Timesheets for Wednesday & Sunday competitions will continue in their current form and bookings will remain on-line.

These arrangements will remain until further notice and will be reviewed and changed if and when required.

We ask members to be considerate of other members and only book required tee times rather than occupying tee times that may not eventually be filled.

Playing Conditions:

Following advice from the various authorities, playing conditions have been reviewed and from Saturday, 5th December, we will be reverting back to normal golf protocols on the golf course.

Members’ Competitions:

- Flagsticks can be removed
- Sand Buckets to be carried
- Rakes will be available in bunkers therefore the “Preferred Lie” rule in bunkers will no longer apply. Local rules will be amended accordingly. Players are encouraged to familiarise themselves with any changes to the rules that may apply.
- Nearest Pins will be back in play.
- Normal score card procedures will return. Player and marker signatures, as well as starting and finishing times required on all competition score cards.

Visitors:

- Visitors will be allowed to play in open competitions.
- No visitors allowed on Saturdays until further notice.

Social Tee Times:

- Mandatory bookings for all players, including members, will continue. All players ***must book*** a tee time if they wish to access the golf course as failure to do so may result in them being turned away. This will assist with traffic through the Proshop and management of Social Distancing on the course.

General:

- No cash will be accepted in the Proshop
- Players to follow Starter's instructions at all times and be ready to move to the first tee when called.
- Players must not proceed onto greens or tees unless they have been vacated by the group ahead.

We wish to remind everybody that although restrictions continue to lift that allow us to return to some levels of normal operation, we should still be mindful that Social Distancing and hygiene protocols **must be followed** in order to remain safe for the benefit of all concerned.

Please comply with all directives from staff at all times and remain aware of your responsibilities to everyone around you. Remember that one person doing the wrong thing can spoil it for all.

Let's stay safe, let's stay aware, let's stay open.
