

## **IMPORTANT UPDATE TO MEMBERS COURSE OPEN & THE FAMILY BRASSERIE OPEN FOR TAKE-AWAY SALES**



Further to the communication sent to members last night, we can now confirm that we have received further notification from Golf NSW that the NSW Government has advised that golf is considered an exercise activity that can continue to be played in line with Public Health Orders relating to public gathering limits and social distancing.

The NSW Government has issued guidelines allowing people to go outside and exercise. Any form of exercise is to be undertaken in compliance with the Public Health Orders. Therefore, individual sports such as golf can continue provided the Public Health Orders are complied with.

What does this mean for Massey Park Golf Club?

The course will be open for play from Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June including Member's comps.

We wish to remind everybody that strict Social Distancing protocols **must be followed.**

### **The following conditions will apply:**

#### **Members' Competitions:**

- All Member's competitions will be as follows:
  - Members Only – (No Visitors)
  - No Nearest the Pins
- Players must check-in via the club's QR code.
- Players are reminded to follow Social Distancing and personal hygiene protocols.
- Players are responsible for returning their cards at the completion of their rounds to the box that will be located at the front of the club.

#### **Time Sheets:**

- Time sheets for Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> & Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> July are now available on-line.
- Times sheets for all future competitions will be released on-line at 6.30pm, 8 days prior to each competition, until further notice.
- Members are urged to use the on-line booking function, when possible, rather than call the Proshop as this will assist staff greatly.
- In these difficult times, we ask members to be considerate of other members and only book required tee times rather than occupying tee times that may not eventually be filled.

## **General Play – All Players**

- Bookings for Social play required for all players, including members.
- Flags to remain in the hole at all times.
- No Rakes in Bunkers or Sand Buckets. 30cm preferred lies permitted in bunkers.
- Players to repair divots and restore bunkers after play by using foot or club where possible.
- No more than two customers in the Proshop at any time.
- No cash will be accepted in the Proshop.
- Players to follow Starter's instructions and only move to the 1<sup>st</sup> tee when called.
- Players must not proceed onto greens or tees unless they have been vacated by the group ahead.
- Other than for Golf, players are to minimise the amount of time spent on the premises.
  - No assembling of groups outside the Proshop.
  - Players to move directly from the Proshop to the tee and from the course to the car park at the completion of their round whilst at all times adhering to Social Distancing protocols.

## **The Family Brasserie:**

The Family Brasserie will be open for take-away sales on Tuesdays to Sundays with orders taken from 4pm to 7.30pm with pick-up from 5pm to 8pm. Orders can be placed by calling 9743 1917 – Option 2. Take-away drink sales will also be available with members able to use their accounts for these purchases. We ask that these orders are placed at the same time as food orders so that we can have them ready for collection at the same time.

All persons collecting take-away orders are required to wear a mask and check-in via the club's QR code displayed in various locations in the entry foyer.

The Club is unlikely to continue to function appropriately without the complete co-operation of our membership. We must all adhere to the health recommendations as our compliance with them will no doubt determine whether it remains safe and advisable to remain open for play.

Members are reminded that we are compelled to consult and take guidance and direction from the various authorities and governing bodies, including City of Canada Bay Council. Circumstances will continue to dictate that these decisions are reviewed regularly and any further necessary changes will be communicated and implemented where possible without delay.

Please comply with all directives from staff whilst on the premises and remain aware of your responsibilities to everyone around you.
