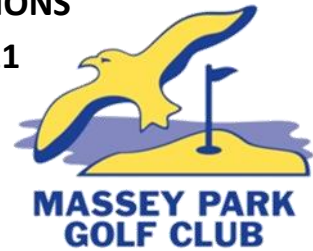


## IMPORTANT UPDATE TO MEMBERS – FURTHER RESTRICTIONS ANNOUNCED EFFECTIVE FROM 5PM, FRIDAY 9<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2021



With the growing number of infectious cases of COVID-19 in the community and unlinked cases of community transmission, COVID-19 restrictions will be tightened across Greater Sydney including the Central Coast, Blue Mountains, Wollongong and Shellharbour.

From 5.00 pm today, July 9th, the following additional restrictions will be in place:

- Outdoor public gatherings limited to two people (excluding members of the same household).
- People must stay in their Local Government Area or within 10 km of home for exercise and outdoor recreation, with no carpooling between non-household members.
- Browsing in shops is prohibited, plus only one person per household, per day may leave the home for shopping.
- Funerals limited to ten people in total (this will take effect from Sunday, July 11th).

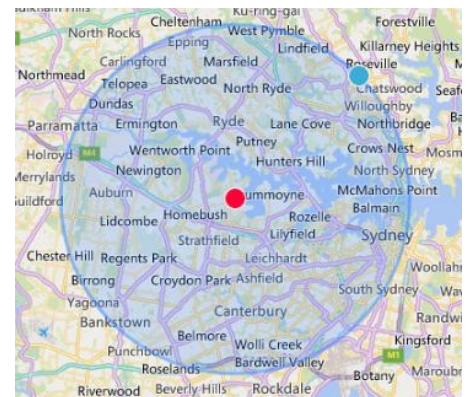
### The four reasons to leave your home remain in place, with additional limitations:

- Shopping for food or other essential goods and services (one person only).
- Medical care or compassionate needs (only one visitor can enter another residence to fulfil carers' responsibilities or provide care or assistance, or for compassionate reasons).
- Exercise with no more than two (unless members of the same household).
- Essential work, or education, where you cannot work or study from home.

Golf is considered exercise, and as such, may continue as long as we have and comply with our COVID-19 Safety Plan, however it is difficult for us to comply with our Safety Plan without the support and co-operation of our members.

### So, what are the main changes that will impact Massey Park members?

- Firstly, we ask that members ensure that they are within the LGA OR 10km requirement. **Please refer to map at the bottom of this notice as a guide.** Members can use the following tool to verify that they comply:

- Playing groups will be limited to no more than two players.
- Only 1 person per cart until further notice.



As always, golfers should exhibit a heightened awareness of personal hygiene and adhere to social distancing guidelines at all times.

We wish to remind everybody that strict Social Distancing protocols must be followed.

**From 5pm on Friday 9th of July 2021, the following conditions will apply:**

**Members' Competitions:**

- All Member's competitions will be as follows:
  - Members Only – (No Visitors)
  - Medley Single Stableford
  - No Nearest the Pins
- Players can mark their own individual/team card however players should verbally confirm their scores on each hole to ensure that correct scores are written on both cards. There is no requirement for the marker to sign the card.
- Players are responsible for returning their cards at the completion of their rounds to the box located at the front of the club.

**Time Sheets:**

- Time sheets that have already been released and populated, will be amended to comply with the new restrictions. These should be available at 5pm tonight. Members are urged to view their amended tee times and if they need to change or cancel their booking, we ask that they do this on-line if possible, to assist Proshop staff who are being inundated with phone calls.
- Time sheets to be released for all future competitions will also be adjusted to comply with new restrictions and will become available on-line at 6.30pm 8 days prior to the event.
- Members will only be able to book themselves and one other player
- In these difficult times, we ask members to be considerate of other members and only book required tee times rather than occupying tee times that may not eventually be filled.
- All players, including members, whether playing in a comp or socially must book in advance. Bookings can be made by calling 9743 3737.

## **General Play – All Players**

- 2 Players per group – 5-minute intervals
- 1 person per cart – 1 golf bag per cart
- Flags to remain in the hole at all times
- No Rakes in Bunkers or Sand Buckets. Players to repair divots and restore bunkers after play by using foot or club where possible
- Face masks are mandatory in the Proshop and at the Half-way House.
- No more than two customers in the Proshop at any time.
- No cash will be accepted in the Proshop or at the Half-way House.
- Players to follow Starter's instructions and only move to the 1st tee when called.
- Players must not proceed onto greens or tees unless they have been vacated by the group ahead.
- Other than for Golf, players are to minimise the amount of time spent on the premises.
  - No assembling outside the Proshop
  - Players to move directly from the Proshop to the tee and from the course to the car park at the completion of their round whilst at all times adhering to Social Distancing protocols.

The Club is unlikely to continue to function appropriately without the complete co-operation of our membership. We must all adhere to the health recommendations as our compliance with them will no doubt determine whether it remains safe and advisable to remain open for play.

Members are reminded that we are compelled to consult and take guidance and direction from the various authorities and governing bodies, including City of Canada Bay Council. Circumstances will continue to dictate that these decisions are reviewed regularly and any further necessary changes will be communicated and implemented where possible without delay.

Please comply with all directives from staff whilst on the premises and remain aware of your responsibilities to everyone around you.
